

Emergency Voice Communication & Disabled Refuge Systems

Current Building Regulations insist on all new non-domestic buildings with more than one storey provide 'refuge' areas - relatively safe places where people who cannot easily use fire escapes and evacuation lifts can call for assistance and wait until help arrives.
